Camp Jabez House Needed

It has been a while since we have had any major improvement projects but now this is a must. You may have heard the old Christian song This Old House. (Stuart Hamblem, 1954)

The current "house" for our Equine Director is actually a double-wide trailer which has had all the repairs is can take...the floor is really falling through. The position of Equine Director is at the heart of the equine operation; horses need constant attention around the clock. It takes a special person with God given motivation to serve in this position.

So we are asking for the funds to bring this to pass. We hope to use a Unibilt home which will save a goodly amount of funds and still provide the housing we need; simple three bedroom, bath, kitchen and living area. The excavation and house are estimated at \$280,000. Our time frame is to start the ground work this year and complete by mid-2024.
